BREAKFAST CLUB

A survey was sent to all parents to gather information about whether there is a need for a Breakfast Club in St. Senan's. Results from the recent survey are as follows (46 families responded):

- 80.4% feel a breakfast club is needed
- 69.6% want their child to use breakfast club
- 37% will use it every day, 17.4% will use it 2/3 days, 10.9% once a week, remainder 3/4days & not at all

The school is currently looking at ways to source funding for the club and looking to run the club on a trial basis. We will update you as soon as we have further information.

LIFE SKILLS TRAINING

Múinteoir Barry's class have been chosen for the delivery of the Botvin Lifeskills Programme. This aims to develop children's emotional health and wellbeing by providing them with skills, knowledge and attitudes necessary to make healthy choices.
